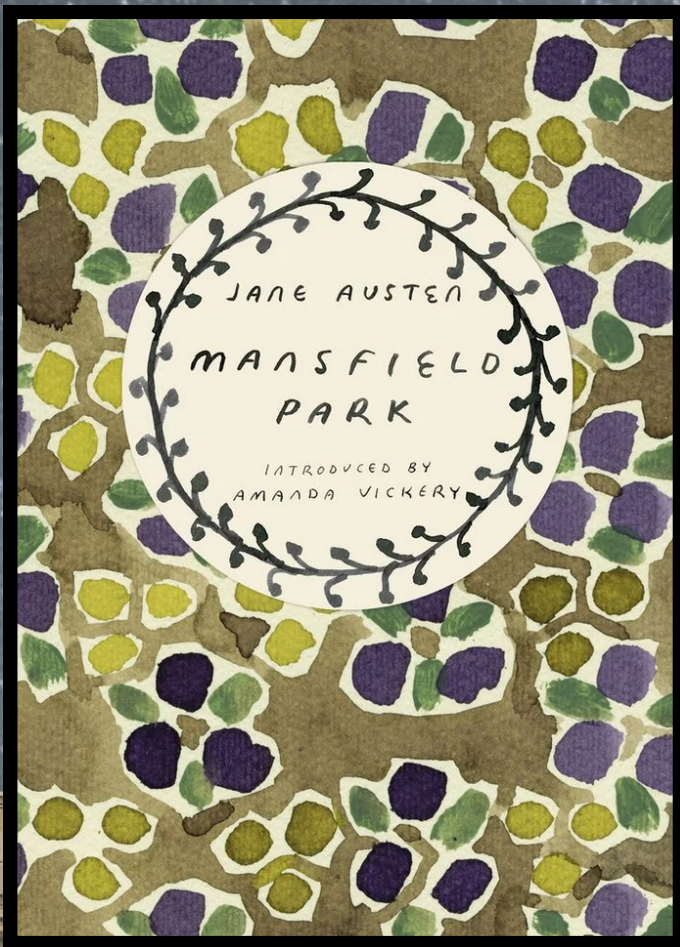

Her only ally is her cousin Edmund. When her cousins befriend two glamorous new young people who have arrived in the area, Henry and Mary Crawford, Edmund starts to grow close to Mary and Fanny finds herself dealing with feelings she has never experienced before.

Mansfield Park is considered Jane Austen's first mature work and, with its subtle examination of social position and moral integrity, one of her most profound.
