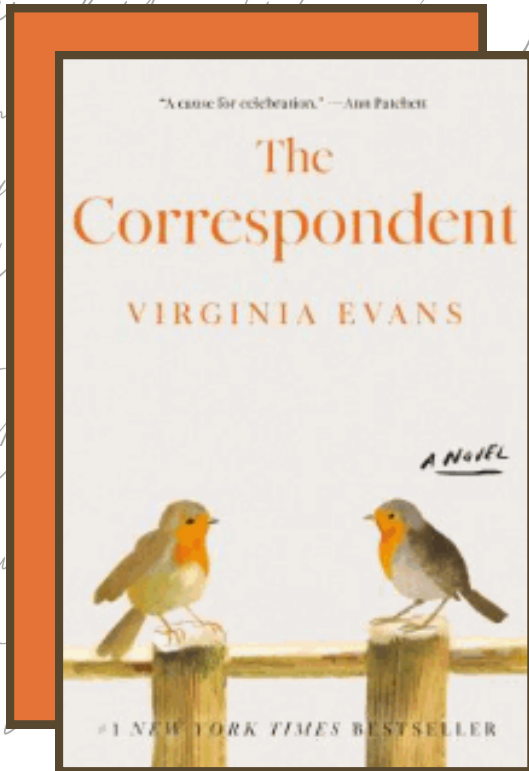


EVENING BOOK CLUB
